## **Information & Registration**

**Tuesday – Tuesday, June 8 – 15**  
**Registration Deadline: Monday, May 24**

*Details about the June Mystery Cruise are in the April Jib Sheet. The latitude and longitude for the northern and southern boundaries are included in the article. You will need to have charts of this area on board and available for use.*

### **Tuesday, June 8:** (27nm)

Enjoy the cruise while you take in the sights to your first destination. Get settled in and join your fellow cruisers at 1700 for BYOB drinks, snacks, and some good conversation followed by dinner and dessert provided by your cruise directors (CDs).

### **Wednesday, June 9:** (8nm)

Once you have plotted your next destination, you will be free to proceed to Wednesday's port of call. Today is a free day to enjoy your surroundings. There will be snacks on the dock at 1700 provided by the CDs; BYOB drinks. Dinner is on your own.

### **Thursday, June 10:**

This is a great day to sleep in, however, there will be a training exercise sometime during the morning. Once completed you will have time to stroll the area, go for a hike, read, eat or play games. BYOB drinks begins at 1700. There will be a barbeque following the cocktail hour at approximately 1800. Barbequed pork ribs will be provided by the CDs and side dishes/desserts will be assigned to cruisers.

### **Friday, June 11:** (28nm)

With your course plotted, you can proceed to the next destination. Take time to enjoy the area you travel through. There might even be some sights along the way you will want to remember. Once in the marina, you have the rest of the day free. There are no planned activities.

### **Saturday, June 12:**

### **Sunday, June 13:** (20nm)

We will gather at 1700 for BYOB drinks, and a variety of assigned heavy hors d'oeuvres that hopefully will reduce or eliminate your desire for dinner.
