Cruise Registration Deadline Extended to Thursday, April 22nd

Sunday, May 9, Friday Harbor, San Juan Island, WA

Moorage Rate: \$1.00/ft with electricity; \$0.90/ft no electricity

Monday, May 10--Otter Bay, Pender Island, BC

Moorage Rate: \$1.35/ft and \$5 for 15 amp; \$7 for 30 amp; \$9 for 50 amp

Tuesday/Wednesday, May 11/12--Coal Harbor, Vancouver, BC

Moorage Rate: \$2.10/ft and \$5 for 30 amp; \$10 for 50 amp

Thursday, May 13--Bowen Island, Union Steamship Marina, BC

Moorage Rate: \$1.50/ft and \$5 for power

Friday, May 14--Blaine Marina, WA

Moorage Rate: \$0.75/ft and \$5 for power

Saturday/ Sunday, May 15/16--Cap Sante Marina, Anacortes, WA

Moorage Rate: 0.70/ft and \$4 power: *For a stay of two nights the fee is 25% of normal rate.*
